Infant School: 8.45am - 3.15pm

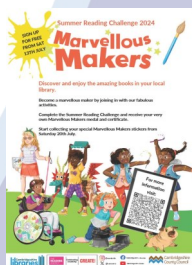
Preschool: 9.00am - 3.00pm

They will be entered into a **Prize Draw** for a super prize. How exciting!



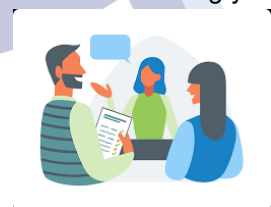
Meet the Teacher
